INFORMATION HELP-Link is a free workforce program for Montanans covered by Medicaid under the Montana HELP Plan.

Created by the HELP Act, HELP-Link connects Medicaid enrollees with high quality workforce training, employment services and job openings in local communities.

Employment services offered through HELP-Link and Montana’s Job Services include:

Assistance with resume and cover letters, job applications and interview skills

Resource center for job seekers including the Montana Career Information System (MCIS)

Labor market information and skills testing

Assistance for veterans of the military and eligible spouses
