State Workforce Investment Board:

This is a request for an additional \$6,000 to supplement the board's Feb. 11, 2010 grant to pilot WorkKeys testing in the Great Falls Public Schools during the 2010-2011 school year.

When I made my presentation to the board I did so with what I thought were assurances that I could count on preparing students for the tests with WIN curriculum under a state license. WIN subsequently decided that the license, itself in a pilot, would be terminated.

That left me in a position of having authorization to WorkKey test, but no curriculum to prepare students for the test.

WIN has quoted me a price of \$6,000 to use its software next school year. My request to you is to grant that amount of money.

I would be happy to meet with the board at its May 6 meeting in Great Falls if you think it necessary.
