youth.

SYNOPSIS If the Education and Training Committee wanted to form a Youth Committee, the committee would focus on programs

geared to making youth ready for the workforce and ensuring the State of Montana's workforce system is designed to assist both in-school and out-of-school youth fully participate and

have access to employment opportunities.

- Job Corps Representatives
- Corrections Representatives
