- The BSTF Program is a state-funded program to assist in economic development for Montana.
- The Legislature created the BSTF Trust Fund which is a designated fund within the permanent Coal Trust Fund.
- Program is funded through the interest off the BSTF Trust Fund.
- Two eligible activities Job Creation and Planning

PURPOSE

- Create good-paying jobs for Montana residents,
- Promote long-term, stable economic growth in Montana,
- Encourage local economic development organizations,
- Create partnerships between the state, local governments, tribal governments, and local economic development organizations that are interested in pursuing these same economic development goals,
- Retain or expand existing businesses,
- Provide a better life for future generations through greater economic growth and prosperity in Montana,
- Encourage workforce development, including workforce training and job creation, in High-Poverty Counties by providing targeted assistance, and
- Manufacturing ammunition components is a qualified economic development purpose.

WHO CAN APPLY

Awards are made to Certified Regional Development Corporations (CRDC), tribal governments and other eligible economic development organizations.


Typical project awards are \$27,000 with local match.

ELIGIBLE ACTIVITIES

- Support for business improvement districts and central business district re-development,
- Industrial development,
- Feasibility studies,
- Creation and maintenance of baseline community profiles,
- Matching funds for federal funds,
- Preproduction costs for film or media, and
- Administrative expenses.



- Since the inception of the Program, over \$5 million of planning funds have been awarded.







JOB CREATION PROJECTS







WHO CAN APPLY

- Local and tribal governments apply on behalf of an eligible assisted businesses
- The assisted business needs to:
 - Have a focus on out-of-state markets and clients <u>or</u> a business that engaged in business activities that will provide a sufficient positive economic impact to the community, regional and state beyond job creation or provide an essential service or function.
 - Create at least one job that pays, as a minimum, 170% of Montana's current minimum wage. The value of employee ERISA benefits can be included in the calculation to meet the wage.




HOW MUCH CAN APPLY FOR

- <u>\$5,000</u> per BSTF eligible job created and for projects located in a non-high poverty county with \$1 for \$1 match requirement
- <u>\$7,500</u> per BSTF eligible job created and for projects located in high poverty county with \$1 for \$2 match requirement.
- Reimbursement is based on the number of jobs created and amount of eligible expenses and match.





POVERTY MAP



90-1-201 (2)(d), MCA "High-poverty county" means a county in this state in which 14% or more of people of all ages are in poverty as determined by the U.S. Census Bureau estimates for the most current year available.



ELIGIBLE ACTIVITIES

- Reduction in the interest rate of a commercial loan;
- Grant or low interest loan for relocation expenses;
- Rental assistance or lease buy-downs for a relocation or expansion project;
- Grant or Purchase of Land, Building or Equipment;
- Wages of Net New Employees;
- Construction Materials, and
- Employee Training.

FUNDED PROJECTS

- ADF International, Inc. 146 jobs, \$983,700
- All American Pharmaceutical 34 jobs, \$170,000
- SmartLam, LLC 29 jobs, \$217,500
- Montana Instruments Corporation 17 jobs, \$127,500
- Glacier Hops Ranch, LLC 5 jobs, \$37,500

Since the inception of the Program, over \$14 million of job creation funds have been awarded.
